0610/664 Apologies for absence

Apologies were received from Cllrs R Heffer, G Wallis and T. Watson

0610/665 Declarations of Members Interests

There were no declarations of interest

0610/666 Public Speaking

Police:

- Crime Figures for May 2010 (April figures in brackets):-
Assaults 2 (2): Criminal Damage 4 (1): Burglary Dwelling 1 (1): Burglary Non-dwelling 0 (1): Theft from motor vehicle 0 (1): Theft of motor vehicle 0 (1): Total Crimes 7 (7):
Nuisance Incidents 11 (20). The report detailed the types of incidents listed.
- The assaults included brawls and smashed property. The burglary was a sneak in. The nuisance incidents included drunks, motorbikes, neighbour disputes and some problems with large numbers congregating at Shetland Road.
- It was reported that PCSO Brownlee had undertaken high visibility patrols, conducted crime and house to house enquiries. He had been targeting nuisance youths on the Shetland Road playing fields
- The next police surgery was due to be held on Thursday 1 July at Tibshelf Methodist Church.

County Council:

- Cllr. Moesby reported that priority markings had been ordered for Arran Court following reports of problems by residents. He also informed members about a fun day which was being held called Dads in the Park. There had been a marked reduction in fly tipping recording a 27% drop in incidents. A member asked the County Councillor to investigate whether the footpath between St Thomas Close and the school was the responsibility of DCC as the surface was very poor. A member also enquired about the policy relating to disabled parking spaces which had been marked out near residential properties for the use of a particular disabled resident and what happened when that resident left the property. Councillor Moesby also referred to the current status of the new school development. He reported that the application was in its final stages with Partnership for Schools but that there was currently no movement.

District Council:

- Cllr Brindley had nothing to report in relation to District Council business

Other issues raised:

Two members of the public were present and thanked the parish council for successfully pursuing a public meeting with Westleigh Developments.

Three representatives of the Youth Service were present and produced a draft schedule of activities for the Tibshelf Area. The new Manager, Janice Hacz was present and introduced herself to members.

A member informed the Parish Council that the Football Club had accessed some Arts funding to support an arts project at the recreation ground. The project was to be run by an artist and the young people from the football club had suggested a decorated arch entrance for the ground. The member asked whether the parish council would be supportive of the proposals. It was agreed that the parish council would support the project subject to the design being presented prior to the work being undertaken

A member raised an issue concerning problems of people disposing of dog foul bags in private gardens at the bottom of Hardwick Street because there was no dog bin available. It was proposed by Councillor Foley, seconded by Councillor Brindley and RESOLVED to purchase and install a dog bin on Hardwick Street and to make arrangements with Bolsover District Council for the emptying.
