

**Minutes of the MEETING of TIBSHELF PARISH COUNCIL**  
**held in The Parish Meeting Room, Tibshelf Village Hall, 110 High Street, Tibshelf. DE55**  
**5NU on Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> March 2011 at 7.00pm**

**NON EXEMPT ITEMS**

**0311/766 Apologies for absence**

Apologies for absence were received from Cllr T Watson; County Cllr C Moesby advised that he would arrive late.

**0311/767 Declarations of Members Interests**

Cllr J Gilbody declared a Personal Interest in Planning items 13.1 and 13.2 as he knew the applicants.

Cllr R Heffer, and Cllr P Trevelyan declared a Personal Interest in Item 15 Accounts for Payment as they both knew the contractor Mr. R Cook.

**0311/768 Public Speaking**

**Members of the Public:**

Cllr Beckett spoke on behalf of the Football Club, and reported that the Pavilion had been left unlocked on Friday evening, and that the Pavilion building and football pitch had been affected by graffiti. The Football Club had contacted Sheepbridge Cricket Club to advise of the damage but the Football Club had received no support in making good the pitch. It was reported that the scorecard shed was insecure and in a poor state of repair. Councillor Heffer advised that he would meet with a contractor on site to discuss the options for repair.

Cllr Beckett reported that the Football Club intended to install a Memorial Bench at the Pavilion in memory of Mr Chris Thompson, in replacement of one of the damaged benches.

**Police:**

PC Lorna Evans attended the meeting and submitted a written report for Members' information.

Crime Figures for February 2011 (January figures in brackets):-

Assaults 1 (1): Criminal Damage 2 (3): Burglary Dwelling 1 (1): Burglary Non-dwelling 0(0): Theft from motor vehicle 0(4): Theft of motor vehicle 1 (0): Total Crimes 5 (9): Nuisance Incidents 11 (10). The report detailed the types of incidents listed.

- The assaults were a spitting incident at Tibshelf School. The criminal damages were a domestic where the damage had been paid for and a wing mirror kicked off on High Street. The burglary was a distraction break on Hawthorne Avenue using the Water Board MO. There were no non-dwelling breaks or theft from vehicles. A motorbike had been stolen from a driveway on Peveril Road.
- The nuisance incidents were nuisance kids on Vicar Lane x 3, noise nuisance from neighbours on Derwent Drive, youths being a nuisance in cars on High Street, noise nuisance from neighbours on Overmoor View, youths on the park on Staffa Drive, a neighbour dispute on High Street, stones being thrown from the motorway bridge and kids pretending to put wire across the road on High Street.
- The next surgery was at Tibshelf Methodist Church on 7<sup>th</sup> April 2pm – 3pm and 6pm prior to parish council meeting on 19<sup>th</sup> April.

### **County Council:**

Councillor Moesby attended the meeting and reported on the following:-

- The service of loaning CD's was to be withdrawn from Libraries and the CD's to be sold off to raise funds.
- 23 dedicated school grants were not now to be ringfenced which would leave £70 million available this year for schools. This would equate to approximately a £6 million shortfall due to the reduction in pupil numbers. Schools would have to foot inflationary increases themselves.
- Cllr Moesby had tried unsuccessfully to get a meeting with Cllr Mike Longden (Cabinet member for Education) to discuss Tibshelf School. Capital monies had been received by DCC but the situation regarding Tibshelf School was still unclear. It was agreed that the Parish Council write to DCC to lobby for the provision of capital monies to support Tibshelf School with a copy to Cllr Moesby.
- There were still concerns regarding funding for Adult Social Care.
- Cllr Moesby reported that the County Council would be prepared to install bollards on behalf of Tibshelf Parish Council to alleviate the problem of parking at the front of the High Street flats.
- Cllr Moesby had given a grant of £150 to Tibshelf Allotment Association.
- Cllr Heffer asked about lowering the height of the road hump outside the Infant School. Cllr Moesby would arrange a site visit to investigate.

### **District Council:**

- Councillor Heffer informed members that the Alliance between Bolsover District Council and North East Derbyshire District Council had now been signed.

### **0311/769 Minutes of the Meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> February 2011**

It was PROPOSED by Councillor Heffer, SECONDED by Councillor Vardy and RESOLVED that the Minutes of the Council meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> February 2011, be approved as an accurate record and were duly signed by the Chairman.

### **0311/770 Chairman's Announcements**

- The Parish Newsletter had been completed and distributed, copies were circulated to members at the meeting.

### **0311/771 Village Hall Sub Committee**

It was PROPOSED by Cllr Beckett, SECONDED by Cllr Trevelyan and RESOLVED that the minutes of the meeting held on 8<sup>th</sup> March 2011 be accepted and that the following recommendations be approved:

- That Trish Liversidge of Blackwell Children's Centre be welcomed to the Committee.
- That the request for free use by the Census coordinator be declined.
- That the Sunday hourly rate be increased to £10 per hour in line with the Saturday rate.

**0311/773 Local Government Pension Scheme.**

It was reported to Council by the Clerk that the employer's contributions to the Pension scheme would raise to 15.2% from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2011 which would result in increased contributions by the Parish Council of £220 per annum.

**0311/774 Update on Proposals for old Race Track at Shetland Road.**

The Clerk reported that she and a representative of Digley and Company had made a site visit to the Track area and that the report was awaited.

**0311/775 Access for Emergency and Service Vehicles to Lincoln Street and Vicinity.**

Council were advised that the issue of double parking in the above area and the problems encountered as a result by emergency vehicles and refuse collection vehicles in gaining access to properties in this area were again being experienced. It was RESOLVED that an article on this topic be added to the next newsletter and that Bolsover District Council be asked to write to residents in this area again.

**0311/776 Christmas Lights**

One quotation had now been received from Mr P Goodacre for giving the Plinth a facelift in the sum of £1370 for a stone surround and £1050 for a brick surround.  
Information was still being collated on a number of different Christmas tree options

**0311/777 Applications for Funding Support**

Members considered an application for funding support from Derbyshire Children's Holiday Centre who provided residential weekly holidays for disadvantaged children aged between 7yrs to 13 yrs resident within the parishes of Derbyshire. It was PROPOSED by Councillor Heffer, SECONDED by Councillor Vardy and RESOLVED that a grant of £50 be made.
