1010/703 Apologies for absence

Apologies for absence were received from Councillors C Barlow, A J Boyer, J L Gilbody and T Watson

1010/704 Declarations of Members Interests

Councillor Vardy declared a personal interest in Item 8 – Applications for Funding Support as a relative was involved in the running of the organisation.

1010/705 Public Speaking

Public Speaking:

A member of the public raised a number of issues relating to –

- Using local businesses whenever possible
- Whether the council could investigate superspeed internet connections for the parish
- How problems which were the responsibility of other agencies were dealt with
- The siting of the container on Shetland Road recreation area

Police:

PC Evans attended the meeting and submitted a written report for Members' information.

Crime Figures for September 2010 (August figures in brackets):-

Assaults 6 (4): Criminal Damage 6 (6): Burglary Dwelling 1 (1): Burglary Non-dwelling 0 (1): Theft from motor vehicle 8 (6): Theft of motor vehicle 1 (3): Total Crimes 22 (21): Nuisance Incidents 9 (10). The report detailed the types of incidents listed.

- The assaults included 4 domestic incidents. Criminal damage included damage to cars, damage to a fence, and greenhouse glass broken. The dwelling burglary was a domestic incident. The theft from vehicles were at Tibshelf services and Emo Oils. The stolen motor vehicle was a hire car which had been left for collection. The nuisance incidents had been on Monsal Crescent, Derwent Drive, Peveril Road, Overmoor View, Vicar Lane and Lincoln Street.
- 2 males and 1 female had been placed on acceptable behaviour contracts
- The next surgery was due to take place at Tibshelf Methodist Church on 4th November.

Councillor Heffer reported that he had donated a new mobile phone to the police beat team.

County Council:

- Cllr. Moesby reported that the County Council produced a Community Safety Bulletin for each of the districts in the County and he provided a copy for Members' information. He had also asked for the Clerk to be placed on the distribution list.
- DCC proposed to consult on changes to public transport:
 - Stopping subsidies on 30 bus services
 - Ending half fare travel on local trains for Gold Card holders
 - Reducing fares subsidy for b-line card holders
 - Reducing the subsidy on school bus fares
 - Stopping free travel on Community Transport Dial-a-Bus services for Gold Card holders
- A report was to be considered relating to an increase in the budget for the current scheme for the provision of grit bins
- A delegation had been to London to lobby for the reinstatement of the new Tibshelf School
