**1109/537 Apologies for absence**

Apologies were received from Cllrs G Foley and T Watson due to work commitments.

**1109/538 Declarations of Members Interests**

Cllr Beckett, Cllr Brindley, Cllr Gilbody and Cllr Vardy declared a personal interest in item 13 as the applicant was known to them, Cllr Boyer and Cllr Heffer declared a personal interest in item 15 as a person was known to them and Cllr Trevelyan declared a personal interest in agenda item 9 as the contractor was known to them.

**1109/539 Public Speaking**

**Police**

PCSO Paul Brownlee attended the meeting and submitted the following report:-

- PCSO Brownlee reported that there had been no one attend the OzBox sessions which had been organised for Friday nights and it had therefore been decided to cancel the remaining two sessions and try again in the new year.
- The Saturday afternoon surgeries had also had no uptake so far but it was planned to continue those on the arranged dates.
- PCSO Brownlee detailed the duties he had undertaken in Tibshelf during the past month which included truancy patrols during the day, nuisance patrols in the evening and nuisance motorbike patrols along the 5 pits trail. He had also conducted house to house enquiries related to local burglaries and assisted with school crossing patrols. He also assisted PC Evans in special operations to deter anti social behaviour on mischief night and bonfire night

**County Council**

- Cllr Moesby informed Members that he had been consulted in relation to the proposal for speed limit changes on the B6039 Temple Normanton to Tibshelf Road. The proposal included plans to introduce a 50 mph speed limit between Holmewood and Tibshelf. Councillor Moesby had submitted his support to the proposals with a

recommendation that the current 30 mph speed limit starting on the outskirts of Tibshelf be extended

#### **1109/540 Minutes of Meetings**

#### **1109/543 Sportsground Working Party**

Councillor Brindley reported on the meeting of the Sportsground Working Party held on 10<sup>th</sup> November 2009. Discussions at the Working Party had centred around the standard of the playing field and the feasibility of upgrading it with improved drainage. Members referred to a survey which had been carried out in the past and the Clerk was asked to look out the results of that survey before action was taken on commissioning any further surveys. It was further agreed that contact be made with DCC to determine their plans for the future of the current playing fields and Multi Use Games Area once the new school was operational.

#### **1109/544 Draft Lease - Sportsground**

The Clerk circulated a copy of the proposed draft lease relating to Tibshelf Sportsground at Shetland Road between the Parish Council and Tibshelf Football Club and Sheepbridge Cricket Club. It was proposed by Councillor Heffer and seconded by Councillor Gilbody and RESOLVED that the lease be approved and finalized and signed on behalf of the Council.

#### **1109/545 Quotation for photocells – lighting at Church**

Members considered a quote which had been received for the installation of photocells in three floodlights at the Church in the sum of £111.00. It was proposed by Councillor Vardy seconded by Councillor Brindley and RESOLVED that the quotation be accepted.

#### **1109/546 Purchase of Slate Chippings - Cemetery**

The Clerk referred to a decision which had been taken in September 2008 for the replacement of an area at the cemetery currently covered by bark with slate chippings. The current estimate for the purchase of the chippings was approx £900 with an additional £60

for a membrane. It was proposed by Councillor Beckett, seconded by Councillor Vardy and RESOLVED that the estimate be accepted and that the chippings and membrane be purchased

**1109/547 Application to install memorial seat**

The Clerk reported receipt of an application for the installation of a memorial seat at Tibshelf Cemetery from Mr M Woolley. It was proposed by Councillor Gilbody, seconded by Councillor Heffer and RESOLVED that the application be approved in accordance with the current council policy.

**1109/548 Proposed speed limit changes B6039 Temple Normanton to Tibshelf**

The Clerk reported receipt of a consultation from Derbyshire County Council relating to a proposal to change speed limits on the above stretch of road. The proposal included a 50 mph speed limit between Holmewood and Tibshelf because of the collision history along this rural route.

Councilor Moesby had reported earlier in the meeting that he had supported these proposals with an amendment that the current 30 mph speed limit should be extended further out of the village to meet the proposed 50 mph speed limit. Members agreed that the parish council should support this amendment. It was further agreed that DCC should be informed that whilst the parish council were in support of the proposals there should be more emphasis on the enforcement, not only of the proposed limit but also the existing limits already in place around the village.
