0501/010 PLANNING MATTERS

The planning group was not quorate prior to the Council meeting but referred the following planning application to the meeting.

05/00010/FUL Erection of 2m timber security fence/noise barrier to NE & NW at the Model Racing Club for Stewart Rease.

It was resolved

To object to this application on the following ground and to request that conditions be attached to the application

- Objection Object on grounds of use of razor wire as a danger to public
- Condition Fence must be maintained to the satisfaction of the Local Authority
- Condition The fence must provide a suitable level of noise reduction
- Condition Fence must have suitable screening and be an appropriate colour

Other applications were considered after the Council meeting and will be reported in the future.

It was noted that the sub group appeared not to be operating satisfactorily and that alternatives will be considered.

It was reported that a group is to be set up to organise Christmas 2005 Lights.

Cash Flow

It was reported that the Village Hall could potentially have a cash flow problem in the current financial year but that further work on the analysis of the accounts was required and that audited accounts need to be prepared as soon as possible.

Tenancy at Will

It was reported that the Tibshelf Cardiac Rehabilitation Group (TCRG) were in the process of vacating the Portakabin to the rear of the Village Hall. The Village Hall Management Committee had considered purchasing the building but funds were not available. The Parish Council were invited to consider purchase.

It was resolved that the Tenancy at Will agreement be terminated as soon as practicable and that the TCRG be requested to comply with the terms of the agreement regarding return of the owners property.

It was reported that the annual ROSPA inspection report has been received.

It was resolved that a meeting of the Play Area Sub Committee be convened to discuss this.

0501/016 FREE TREE SCHEME

It was reported that 100 trees had been given to the Parish as part of the DOB free tree scheme. These have been planted on the allotments where they will be left to mature for two years after which they will be transplanted to approved locations.

Discussion took place on the budget implications of supplementary information provided.

It was resolved that the following items be amended

Bus Shelters – £4500 added to allow for construction of replacement anti vandal shelters.

Container provision - £2000 added for the provision of a storage container

Cemetery - £1500 added for the provision of a new footpath and repairs to the existing footpath

Christmas lights - £3500 added towards the cost of providing lights at Christmas 2005

Highways - £2000 added to supplement the road sweeping service provided by DOB where necessary

It was resolved to Precept the District Of Bolsover in the amount of £85,995 for the year 2005/2006
