316/02 MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

The Minutes of the meeting held on 21st May 2002 were confirmed and signed as a true record subject to the following amendment:

317/02 COMMUNITY MATTERS OF CONCERN

- (a) **Potholes on Derwent Drive and Peveril Road** – The meeting was informed that this had already been reported to Councillor Mrs Beckett.
- (b) **New stickers were due for the bins** – The meeting was informed that there had been a printing problem, but this would soon be resolved.
- (c) **Footpath No. 19** - Blackwell Parish Council had reported that Public footpath No. 19 is impassable due to brambles. This is in Tibshelf Parish. **It was resolved** that Councillor Mrs Beckett would pursue this.
- (d) **Probation Service** – **It was resolved** that Councillor Wallis shall liaise with them in the future.
- (e) **Cardiac Rehabilitation Group** – It was reported that the Club had requested access to the toilets in the village hall when they used their cabin. The Clerk informed the meeting that this was an issue for the Village Hall Co-ordinator who was already aware of the issue.
- (f) **Traffic Concerns** – Speeding cars on Peveril Road were a problem. Ideas were put forward for resolving this issue. **It was resolved** that Councillor Mrs Beckett would pursue this with the District Council, PC Smith-beard would look into the problem of speeding on Mansfield Road and Mrs Challands would write to the County Council regarding poor turning into West View.

- (g) **Christmas lights** – It was reported that the Christmas Lights needed an overhaul. **It was resolved** that it would be established what was entailed in carrying out an overhaul.
- (h) **Dustbins** - Councillor Coupe advised that he is trying to ensure that the bins are emptied on schedule, including Bank Holidays. **It was resolved** that Councillor Mrs Beckett would find out how this issue can be solved and that Mrs Challands would write to the District Council regarding the matter.
- (i) **Lighting of Bonfires** – A discussion was held over the legalities of lighting bonfires.
