0605/03 - Minutes of the Annual Parish meeting held on 17th May 2005

0605/04 - Income and Expenditure 2005/2006 and precept 2006/2007

The precept for 2006/7 is £115,229 compared to £85,995 last year, an increase of 34%. This increase is to finance refurbishment of playgrounds, Repairs to the path and a new path in the Cemetery and to finance a full time Parish Clerk to enable the Council function better.

0605/05 - Members attendance at meetings 2005/2006

The meetings through the year had been well attended with three Councillors recording 90% attendance.

0605/06 – Chairman’s Annual Report

This has been a challenging year. The resignation of the Clerk/Village Hall Co-coordinator in October left a functional and administrative vacuum. Creditably, many Councillors gave a considerable amount of personal time to ensure that the Council continued to deliver a service to the Parish. To those Councillors, I would like to offer my gratitude. I would also like to thank Janice Jackson, our temporary acting clerk, for helping us to continue our effectiveness and tie up administrative and financial loosed ends. In spite of these problems the Council delivered essential services to the Parish. It contributed financially to the Carnival and the Firework display, increased the provision of dog bins and grit bins, enhanced the lighting at the Church and has started a major overhaul of play area facilities. The Council supported the community in bringing the Model Car Club issue to a head by providing forums for the community to meet with the Club and Bolsover DC. I am sure that with the support of our new Clerk and Village Hall Co-ordinator our council will continue to provide our parishioners with high quality, good value services for the coming year.

There being no other Parish matters brought forward by the Council or local government electors, the meeting closed at 7.15pm.
